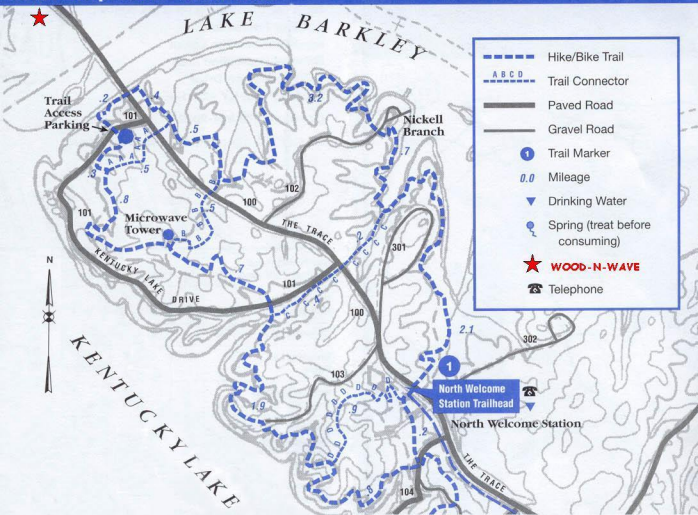


Canal Loop Trail – Hike/Bike



The Canal Loop Trail is a 11.3 mile multiple-use loop trail system that includes four connector trails to offer a variety of hikes and bike rides. The trail can be accessed from either the North Welcome Station Trailhead or the Kentucky Lake Drive Trail Access and is marked by blue metal strips (2" X 6"), while the connectors are marked with yellow metal strips. The North/South Trail connects with the Canal Loop Trail at the North Welcome Station.

The system provides options from 1.5-miles to 14.2-miles in distance and is popular because of the "short hike" potential, less strenuous terrain, and scenic lake views. As always, treat all trail-side water. Treated water is available at the North Welcome Station.

Trailheads: North Welcome Station and Kentucky Lake Drive Trail Access Parking

Trail Connection: North/South Trail

Uses: Hiking, Mountain Biking

Rating: Easy to moderate; 120-foot change in elevation; 14.2 miles.
